- Complete a candidate portfolio
- Demonstrate the ability to teach and examine resuscitation
- Demonstrate the ability to teach and examine unconscious casualty
- Demonstrate the ability to teach and examine incident management
- Demonstrate the ability to deliver a theory topic.

- Delivery of a nominated First Aid At Work micro teach session
- Demonstrate competence in the teaching role of resuscitation, unconscious casualty & incident management for adults, children and babies
- Demonstrate competence in the examination role of resuscitation, unconscious casualty & incident management for adults, children and babies
- Demonstrate competence in the delivery of Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillation (AED)
- Complete a 100-question multiple-choice examination paper.
